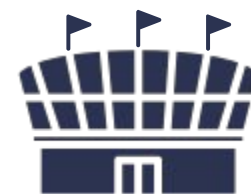

WHAT IS SAFEGUARDING AND WHAT YOUR ROLE AS A COACH IS

Safeguarding is protecting all athletes from harm, abuse, neglect and exploitation.

Making sure there is a positive, safe and respectful environment where they can enjoy twirling and develop their skills without fear.



IMPORTANT

All countries Officials and Coaches have a duty of care to all athletes not just in their own country.



WHY COACHES ARE KEY

- Trustworthy authority figure
- Direct and consistent contact with athletes
- Early identification of concerns
- Countless hours spent together



COACHES RESPONSIBILITIES

Ensure safe training & competitions

Follow safeguarding policies and
procedures

Maintain professional boundaries



RESPONDING TO A CONCERN AT COMPETITION

- Stay calm and listen
- Do not promise confidentiality
- Record facts accurately
- Report to the safeguarding officer nominated by your country



REPORTING A CONCERN AT COMPETITION

- Know your countries nominated safeguarding officer
- Follow reporting chain
- Act immediately if urgent risk

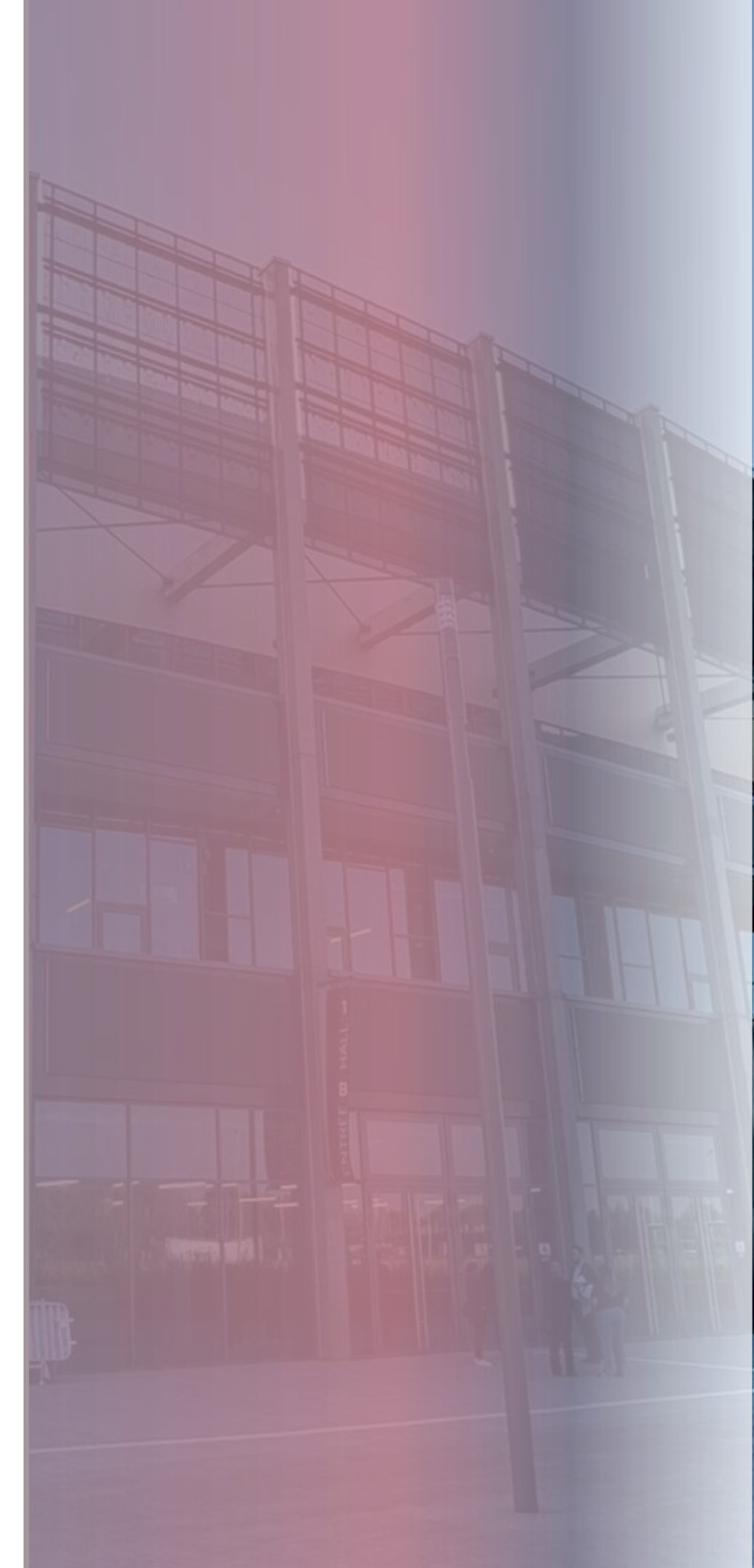

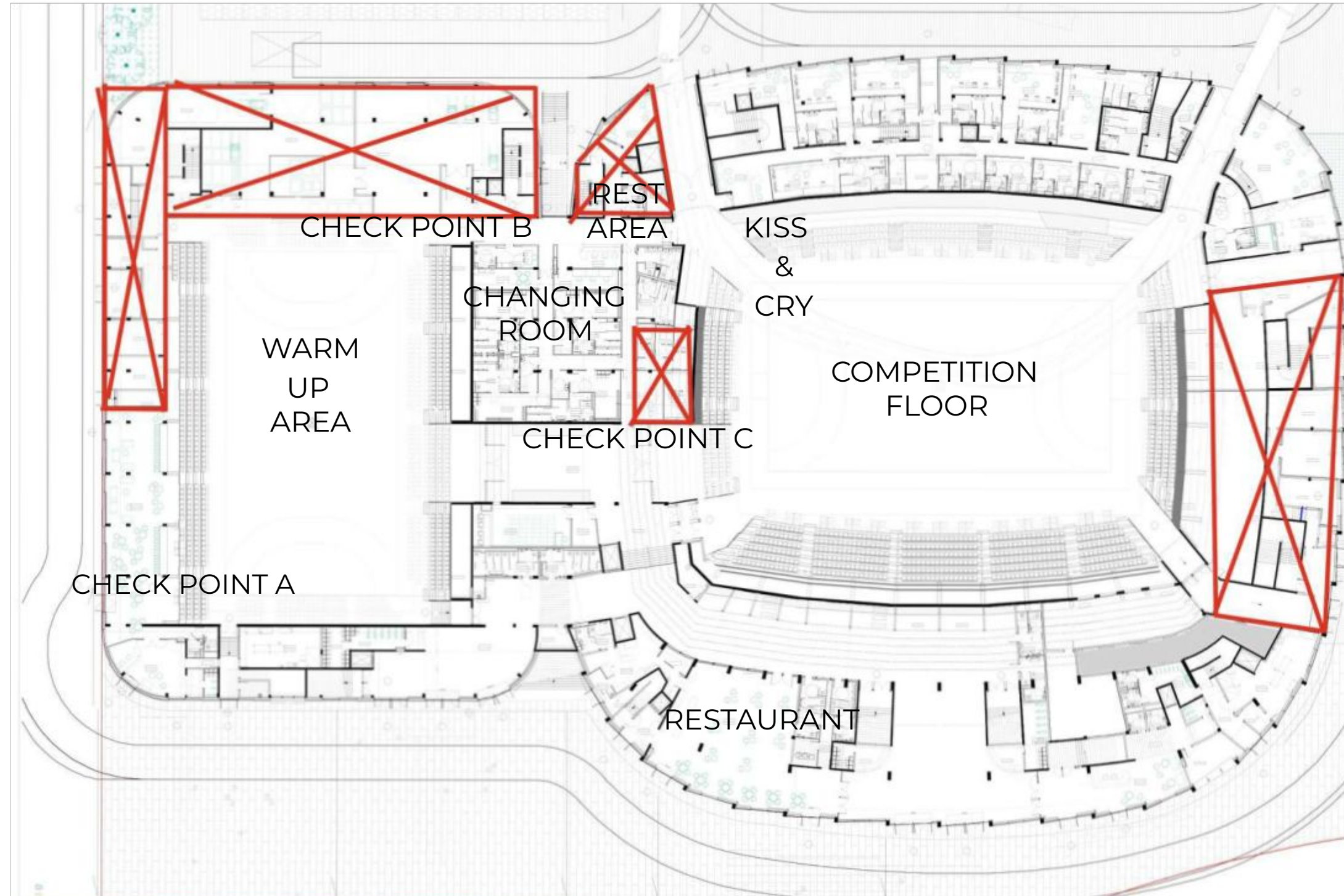
Overview venue layout

Competition Site Map:

- Spectators are invited to park in the car park A.
- Car Park B is reserved for the organisers, officials and VIP guests.
- Athletes, coaches and judges have a dedicated entrance and separate access.
- An event village, housing food and drink outlets and merchandise stalls, are situated right in front of the arena.



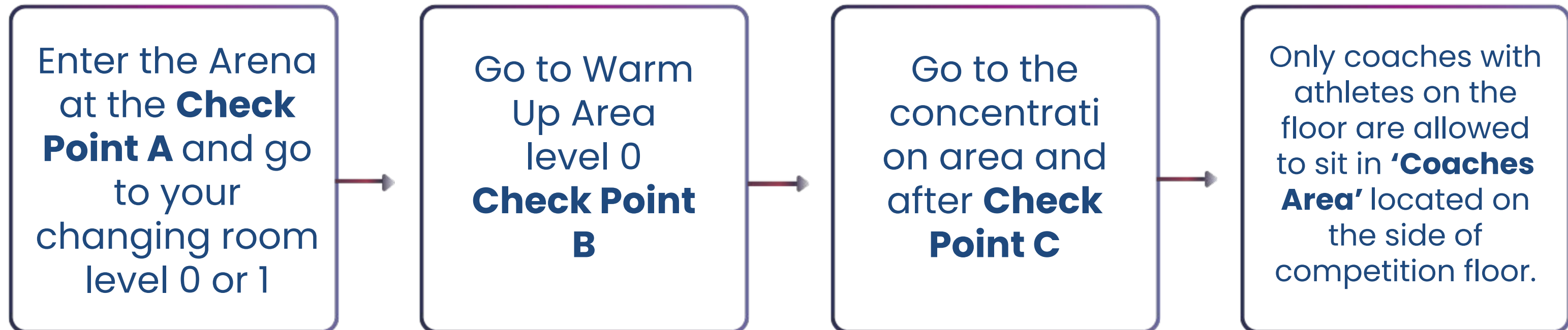
Athletes and coaches circulation



- **CHECK POINT A:** Athletes and coaches entrance
- **CHECK POINT B:** Warm up entrance during competition
- **CHECK POINT C:** Check in to compete
- **WARM UP AREA:** Numbers will be defined and transmitted
- **REST AREA:** Area with water and athletes can go outside after performing
- **RESTAURANT:** Lunches for delegations which have preordered it.

Warm up / Practice area

Warm up area is **ONLY AVAILABLE** to athletes competing in the events of the day.
PLEASE NOTE: ONLY 2 COACHES per athlete is allowed to enter at 'Check Point B'

Tabulation review process with technical advisors

- When the first edition of the results are available they will be shared for TA-review using a google drive share.
- Availability of first edition of result announced in a closed TA-WhatsApp-group.
 - Each country confirms who will be the National Technical advisor/representative for the competition.
- Penalties may be challenged within the 30 minutes following the last competitor in the division.
- Forms available close to the competition floor, preliminary where the athletes will exit. Filled in forms and the payment (\$100) to IBTF Technical Chair
- Window of appeals closure and potential changes after review communicated through TA-WhatsApp-group.

DISPLAY OF SCORES ON THE BIG SCREEN

As IBTF introduces the new judging system for Freestyle Solo at the World Championship, we want to ensure that the timing between the judges' scoring, the tabulation process, and the public display of results is fully synchronized. To support accurate processing and smooth delivery of scores, IBTF has implemented the following procedure for the preliminary qualification round:

Scores for Freestyle Solo will be displayed at the conclusion of each athlete grouping:

- After the first group competes, and once the second group has completed its warm-up, the scores for the first group will be displayed.
- The same sequence will apply for the second and third groups.

This procedure will be used **exclusively** for the preliminary qualification round of both **Freestyle Solo** and **Rhythmic Twirl** to maintain consistency

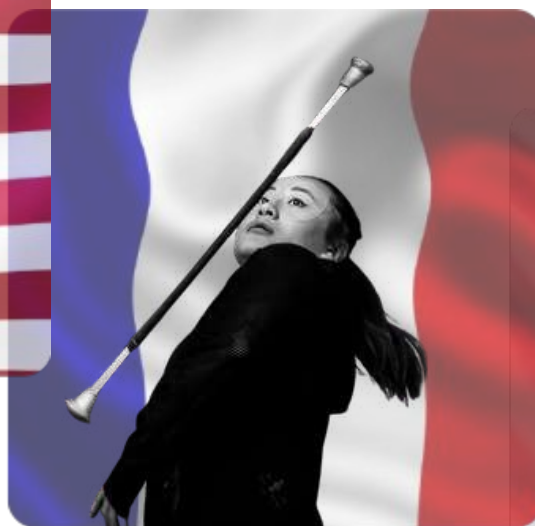

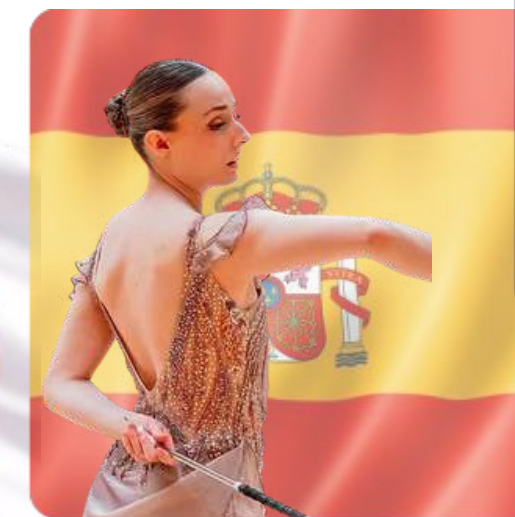

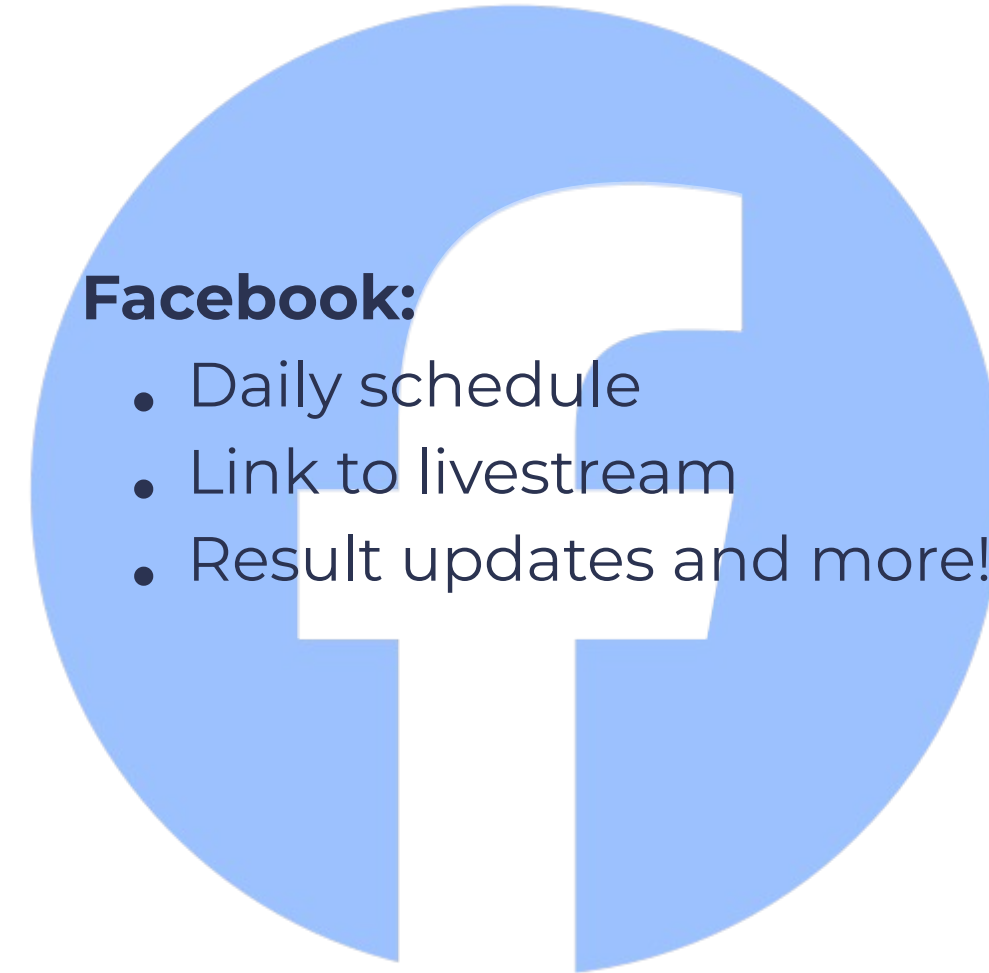
