
- Doors Open
 - MAJORETTE & NATIONS CUP ATHLETES: Doors open at 7:15 AM
 - WORLD TECHNICAL ATHLETES: Doors open at 7:30 AM
 - ALL SPECTATORS: Doors open at 8:00 AM
- Spectator tickets must be purchased online via IBTF website. Assigned seats is enforced. All spectators **MUST** sit in assigned seats.
 - NO TICKETS SOLD ON SITE.
- Bag check may occur for athletes, coaches, officials and all spectators.



BADGE INFORMATION




- Badges must be worn by all athletes and coaches at all times throughout the arena.
- Please connect with your Country Official to collect the athlete and coaches' badges before entering the arena.
- Athletes and coaches must provide a badge upon arrival at the 'Athlete Entrance'
- Athletes **MUST** wear a badge at the following events (in addition to daily competitions):
 - Presentation of Athletes August 3
 - Athletes Party August 3
 - Closing Ceremony August 10
- **IMPORTANT:** All athletes and coaches MUST sit in the 'Reserved Seats' Athletes and coaches are NOT ALLOWED to sit in the spectator sections.




INFORMATION

- From Via Filadelfia 82, you can arrive at the entrance for athletes (Level 0), showing the badge.
- Athletes enter Foyer Fildadelfia

 the LARGEST warm up area (1)
 (ONLY open to athletes
 competing in the day)
- Go downstairs (Level -1) to find the changing rooms area and warm up areas
- Level 0 Access to the reserved seats for athletes and coaches (IMPORTANT: NO ATHLETES IN THE AUDIENCE AREA)
- Level 1 Collect and eat meals in the Foyer Filadelfia
- Level 0 Foyer Sebastopoli (opposite of Foyer Filadelfia) all concessions/bars and sponsors/vendors located here

WARM UP / PRACTICE AREA

Warm-up / Practice Area

Foyer Foladelfia is **ONLY AVAILABLE** to athletes competing in the events of the day. **PLEASE NOTE: ONLY 1 COACH** per athlete is allowed to enter at 'Check Point 1' (except for groups, teams and corps).

Use the general practice area in Foyer Foladelfia - Level 0

Move downstairs to the warm-up floor, to Checkpoint 1, where Athlete & Coaches passes must be shown. Move on to Warm
Up Area 2 and
Checkpoint 2,
at the entrance to
the competition
floor. See flow
chart.

Only coaches with athletes on the floor are allowed to sit in 'Coaches Area' located on the side of competition floor.

IMPORTANT: Ensure you check in on time, if you are late the competition will not wait and you could miss your set and be unable to perform. Please leave the competition floor quickly once the music has ended. Floor Marshals will direct athletes where to stand ready to take the floor for their performances.




At Registration, your federation representative will be shown where the allocated dressing room for your country is.

Athletes should not leave anything of value in any of the dressing rooms, as these are not lockable. Some of the changing rooms are not very big.

Several of the hotels are near the arena, and athletes may find it easier to come already dressed and ready for their performance.







- The Gold Medal team in each Majorette event will receive an 'instruction card' after the awards ceremony with details regarding this honor.
- Athletes selected to carry the IBTF flag during this ceremony will report to PJ Burkin following the World Majorette Championship award ceremony.



A short welcome has been scheduled prior to the start of the World Majorette Championship and World Technical Baton Twirling Championship.

Each ceremony will last **NO LONGER** than 15 minutes. The 'Welcome' will be give by IBTF President, Sandi Wiemers.



AWARD CEREMONIES

- Athletes will be lead by an ITA staff member to the floor for award announcements.

- All athletes will be presented and must be in costume.
- Batons are allowed but phones or tracksuit tops are **NOT** allowed!
- The Champions' National Anthem will ONLY be played for World Majorette Champions and World Technical Baton Twirling Champions.



TWIRLNATIONS CLINIC ENTRY

Registration is NOW CLOSED! No late entries will be taken. Emails will be sent to all participating athletes and coaches regarding entry details.

Proof of purchase / QR Code **WILL BE REQUESTED** at door entry. Please be prepared to provide upon arrival to Inalpi Arena.

PLEASE NOTE: All attendees will enter through the Athletes Entrance and check in begins at approx. 14.50 (2:50 PM CET) at the Foyer Filadelfia.

TwirlNations Clinic Sunday, August 3:

Following the conclusion of competition and awards presentation on August 3, **ALL** athletes, coaches and spectators will be asked to leave the arena.

Clinic will begin at APPROX. 15.00 (3:00 PM CET).



TWIRLNATIONS COACHES CLINIC

PLEASE NOTE: Athletes Clinic will take place in arena. Coaches Clinic will begin in Foyer Filadelfia (Warm Up Area 1) and proceed to 'Judges Room'.



SCORING AND TABULATION

Scores are not displayed during the competition!

However, IBTF does provide a display of the penalties assessed at the completion of each athlete's performance.

In the Nations Cup: Penalty judges are designated to display the content restriction penalties and the number of drops assessed following each performance.

- A **yellow card with black numbers** will be held up to indicate if any content restriction penalties were taken.
- A white card with red numbers will be held up to indicate the number of drops assessed.

NEW THIS YEAR: If the penalty judge flashes a **YELLOW** card for an athlete/pair/team, the judge will write down the content restriction and pass the card to the 'Content Penalty' table. This table is available for coaches to visit within the 30 minute appeals window to understand what the penalty was for. (**Note:** Location of table is TO BE DETERMINED)



SCORING AND TABULATION

In the World Championship: There are content restrictions in Artistic Group and on the number of acrobatic moves in Solo, 2Baton, and 3Baton. And in XStrut, there are other penalties in addition to drops. For all other events, the penalty judges are designated to display the number of drops assessed following each performance.

Yellow card with black numbers will be held up to indicate if content restriction penalties were taken.

White card with red numbers will be held up to indicate the number of drops assessed.

Remember

If an athlete completes their routine with no drops, you won't see any card displayed by the penalty judges. Judges' decisions are considered **final**, and their scores cannot be appealed.

THE EXCEPTION IS PENALTIES.

REVIEW AND APPEALS PROCESS

Penalties questioned for being incorrectly assessed (drops and/or content restrictions) may be challenged ONLY if an Official Appeal Form is submitted to the IBTF Technical Executive Chairs within 30 minutes following the review period by your federation's designated official technical advisor, head coach, or country representative.

- The Request for Review Form may ONLY be submitted by an officially designated delegates.
- **Note:** the results of a division under appeal will not be posted until a review of the appeal has been completed.

Steps for Review and Appeals:

The review involves the IBTF
Technical and Judges Chairs
watching the official video at
the end of the competition day.

The video must clearly prove an error was incorrectly assessed.

The federation will then be notified by email or text of the outcome of the appeal.

The results of the any division that was withheld will then be posted. The posting may not happen until the following morning, depending upon the hour of completion.

APPEALS PROCESS CONTINUED

In order to appeal a penalty, a representative from the affected federation must do so by:

- Completing the official Request to Review Appeal Form (available from the competition office) within the **30-minute review period.**
- The completed form will then be forwarded to the IBTF Technical or Judges Chair who will review the official recording of the performance or will appoint an appropriate and qualified substitute.
- A fee of 100 USD (or equivalent value in host country's currency) must be submitted with the Official Review/Appeals Form (cash only). The money is returned to the submitter, should the appeal result in a change of score, otherwise this fee is retained by the IBTF.



It is important to have a strong case for repeal of the penalty before submitting an Appeal.

Coaches may not submit claims to have an athlete reviewed that is not their own.

SCORING AND TABULATION

- The official tabulation department will send out a notification to all federation's designated technical representative and leadership to review results of an event prior to public and website posting.
- Your country representative and/or your technical representative are responsible for receiving these notifications.
- This **30-minute time period** is used to review and correct any errors and to allow for the appeals process for challenge of penalties (described previously), if necessary. It rarely happens, but is used as a safe guard to protect against having incorrect results publicly posted.
- Once the time period is completed and potential appeals are managed, the results will be publicly posted on the IBTF Website at **ibtf-batontwirling.org**.
